1. Object of the Tender:

This Tender is aimed at PPE providers capable of supplying 20 helmets for motorcycle delivery riders:

1.1 Required Services:

- One-time supply of 20 helmets, full-face or modular flip-up type.
- Must be SABS approved.
- Material: ABS or Polycarbonate; Weight: under 1.6 kg.
- Good airflow ventilation, with front and top vents.
- Visor: Clear, anti-scratch, wide field of view; anti-fog optional.
- Comfort: removable washable liner, padded chin strap, snug fit.
- Reflective detail or stickers for nighttime visibility.

2. Service Period:

Supply to be completed by 5th September 2025.

2.1 Provider Responsibilities:

- Ensure full delivery of goods/services within the service period.
- Maintain communication with Lulalab Foundation for smooth execution.
- Replace or resolve any issues with the goods/services promptly.

3. Lulalab Foundation Responsibilities:

- Provide beneficiary details and allocation support.
- Communicate any changes as directed by the European Union.

4. Contract Duration and Execution:

The contract will commence on 5th September 2025 or the day after formal signing and run until the helmets are supplied.

Any extension due to exceptional circumstances will be communicated in advance, subject to mutual agreement and no increase in budget.

5. Budget and Eligible Costs:

Maximum total budget available: €1,000 (ZAR 20,000.00 including VAT - exchange rate 1€ 20ZAR).

This includes all taxes and covers leasing and related support services.

Lulalab will only pay for completed activities in case of delays or cancellations due to circumstances beyond the provider's control.

6. Tender Selection Criteria

The contract will be awarded based on price, compliance with helmet specification, and ability to deliver within deadline.

7. Billing and Expense Justification

Invoices must be submitted with full breakdown of items, quantities and values. All invoices must refer to the EYWA Project, co-funded by the European Union.

- Full proposal with delivery schedule and specifications

- Pricing breakdown including unit price and VAT
