Objective: To support 20 selected beneficiaries with sustainable self-employment in the delivery sector.

- Scooter bike rental (3 months)
- Petrol vouchers (R1600.00 per month for 3 months)
- Full-face, SABS-approved helmet
- Monthly data vouchers for 3 months
